60% of students from this cohort (2015-2016) have already graduated. Another 10 % of students have scheduled their final defenses in July-August 2023. In addition, 15 % of students are expected to complete their final defenses by the end of the summer term (August 2023). With the 8-year length of the program this year, a total of 85 % of students are expected to complete the program by the end of the summer term (August 2023). 100 % of those who graduated are employed.

33%^^ of students from this cohort (2016-2017) have already graduated, and with the 8-year length of the program, the rest of the students still have one year to complete the program. 100 % of those who graduated are employed.

50%^^^ of students from this cohort (2017-2018) have already graduated, and with the 8-year length of the program, students still have two years to complete the program. 100 % of those who graduated are employed.

0%^^^ With the 8-year length of the program, students still have 3, 4, 5, and 6 years respectively left to complete the program.
